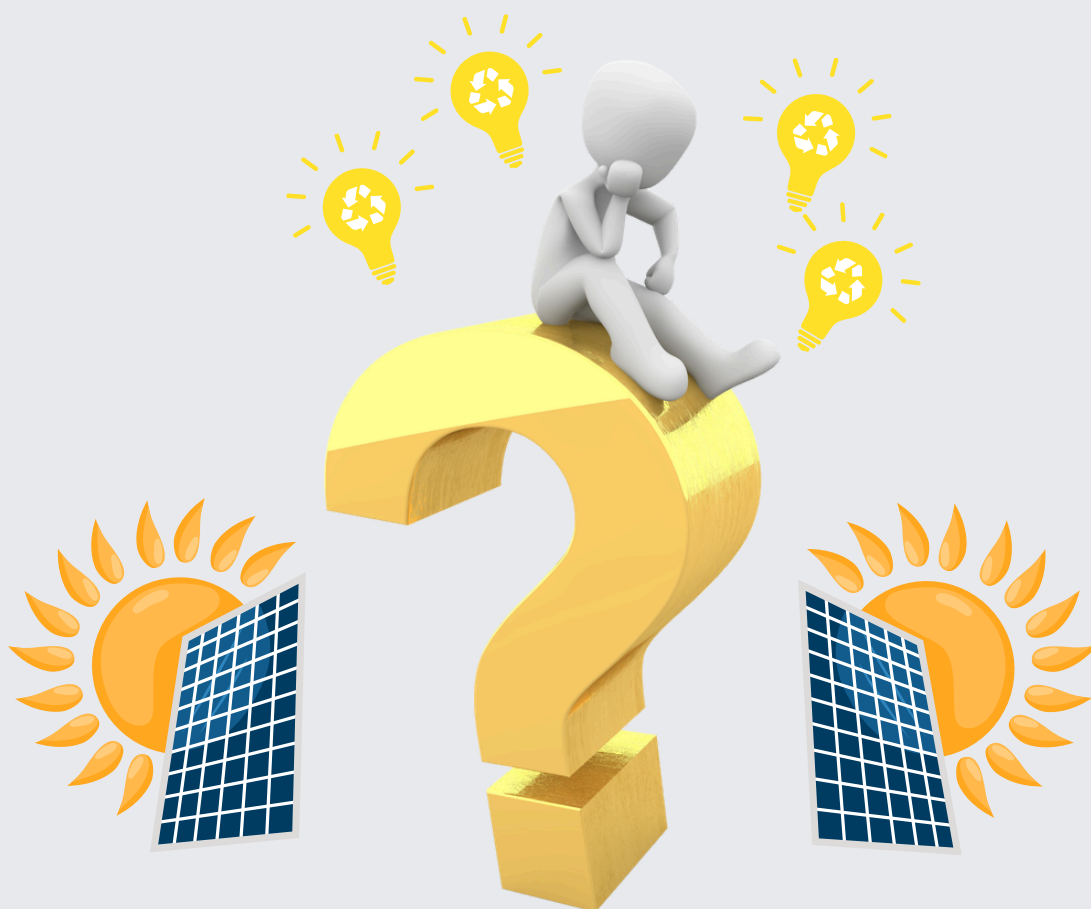

**Do solar panels have any health risks associated with them?**

According to current scientific understanding, there are no significant health risks associated with solar panels when properly installed and maintained.

**What happens if snow and ice accumulate on the solar panels?**

Most solar panels are designed to shed snow fairly well due to their angled installation and the heat they generate, which helps melt the snow and allow them to still produce some power, although not at full capacity. The snow and ice helps to clean the panels

**What happens when my roof needs to be repaired or replaced?**

A licensed solar panel installer would remove the panels if needed. After the roof is replaced or repaired, the installer would reinstall the panels.
